#### **MASCOT AND COLORS**

Hunter Green and White are the school's official colors. The Lion is our school mascot.

#### **WHO WE ARE**

Doris L. Morrow Academy is a private school offering a flexible K-12 Home Education Program for homeschooling families throughout California and the other 50 states that allow it. In addition, we offer academic intervention and tutoring services. California Department of Education CDS # 1964733616379.

Director Kimberly Morrow Brock has been a CA credentialed teacher since 2003 and an administrative credential since 2008. She has been a credentialed teacher since 1997 in NC and later GA.

#### **MISSION**

Empower families to educate their children in ways that allow them to reach their maximum potential academically, socially, and emotionally by providing to curriculum and exposure places/events that are engaging, relevant, and culturally relevant.

#### **Vision**

We strive to prepare all students to become lifelong learners and responsible citizens ready to meet the challenges of the future. In partnership with families and community, our goal is to create relevant learning opportunities for students — both inside and outside the classroom — that help them develop the knowledge, critical thinking skills, and character necessary to succeed independently.

#### **GENERAL ACADEMIC EXPECTATIONS**

Students attending DLMA will be pre-assessed to determine their reading and math levels. Doris L. Morrow Academy provides services designed to remediate learning disabilities or to support developmental disabilities or significant emotional/behavioral challenges.

#### ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS

Students will learn more if they are in attendance regularly. Students who are unable to attend should work on their assignments which will be located in Google Classroom. Since Doris L. Morrow Academy is an Independent Study Program with classroom options attendance is based on work. Therefore, if students are absent for more than one day in a row the expectation is for them to complete their assignments and turn in to be counted towards attendance.

#### STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to wear uniforms. School colors are Hunter Green and White. However, students may wear hunter green, black or white shirts. Boys should wear Polo shirts /button down shirts, pants, jeans or, sweat pants. Girls should wear Polo/button down shirts, pants, jeans, leggings, sweat pants, skirts, skorts, and or dresses.

#### STUDENT BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

#### **FIELD TRIPS**

Students will take part in learning outside of the classroom with field trips throughout the city. Students will be expected to wear their school uniforms, specifically their hunter green shirts and any color bottoms.
